As a school we have worked very closely with the Diocese for many years and earlier in 2015 the IEB decided to join the Trust to begin to work even more closely and to strengthen our Christian ethos and commitment.

This term starts with parent teacher consultations for parents of children in years 1, 3, 4 and 5. There is also the chance for you to see the work your child has been doing, before the consultations take place.
