Dear Parents and Carers,

Many of you will have seen the newspaper reports last week in the Kentish Express reporting on the expansion of Marsh Schools. The Local Authority has requested that St Nicholas increase its pupil admission number from 54 to 60 for the academic year September 2018/2019. The school is currently working with the local authority to ensure that any expansion has a minimal impact on the quality of teaching and learning. As soon as we have any further details we will share this with parents.

Over the last few days we have hosted visits from both the Regional Schools Commissioners Office and the Diocese. Both groups visited to look specifically at learning environments and how we display our children's learning to show their learning journey. I am pleased that our visitors were very impressed and went away pleased with the progress the school is making. It is good to be able to share our children's learning with a wider audience.

In the coming weeks there are some important parent curriculum meetings taking place and I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at these events.
