Dear Parents and Carers,

As I informed everyone in last week's newsletter, we received our first HMI monitoring visit after our Inspection in the Autumn. The official letter outlining the outcomes of the first monitoring visit is available with today's newsletter.

The lead inspector, Mrs Siân Thornton HMI, recognised the schools action plan as being fit for purpose and closely aligned to the schools Statement of Action. Below is a summary of the feedback received by Governors, senior leaders and officers from the local authority:

- The school's calm and purposeful atmosphere reflect the high standards for behaviour and courtesy which have been established. This is an area we will continue to work on.
- The school's plan addresses all the areas for improvement identified by the inspection, allocates clear responsibilities to staff and governors and includes ambitious timescales
- The school has improved the way they assess and record pupils' achievement. Leaders and teachers are using this information increasingly well to check pupils' progress and when they plan for pupils' next steps in learning.
- The Interim Executive Board remains a significant strength. Governors know the school well.

While much has been accomplished, there continues to be a drive amongst the whole staff in continuing to pushing up the standards and outcomes for all pupils across the school. To be successful in this we need to continue to rely on the support of parents in encouraging their children to do the basics well, such as reading regularly and making sure children practise their times table facts and clued spellings as often as possible. By working together, we will make a difference.


Well done to Maple class who achieved 98.8% attendance in the week ending 13<sup>th</sup> May.
