Last week saw the end of all of the National Testing and Phonics Screening across the school. All the children have worked very hard in their different areas, Year 1 & 2 doing the phonics screen, Year 2 and 6 taking part in their end of year assessments. The school this year will have all of its assessments externally audited. This is a robust process which allows us to see if our judgements are in line with national expectations.

This week is Book Week, with today being Book Character Day to kick the whole event off. As a school we have worked very hard this year to raise the profile of reading. While we do as much as we can to encourage the children to read regularly and remind them of the benefits, we rely wholly on you as parents and carers to support us in this aim. It would be great to see higher numbers of readers than usual in Busters Book Club Challenge!

On Friday, we will be visited by Saint Joseph School, from Saint Andre in Lille, France. It will be the first time we will have met with the children of the school. Apart from the French, they have also prepared their pen friend postcards in readiness for the visit. The day promises to be filled with fun and we are grateful to St Mary in the Marsh Twinning Association for all their support and help in setting up the visit.
