School dinners cost £2.20 per day or £11 per week

A polite reminder, dinner must be ordered in advance for the days they are required. The kitchen are very happy to accept payment for dinners on odd days such as Wednesday roast or Friday chip day, but these must be paid for on the Monday and not on the day they are required. Our catering company will soon be providing parents with the opportunity to make payments online we will inform you as soon as this facility becomes available.

### **ParentMail**

At St Nicholas we try very hard to keep parents/carers regularly informed about what is happening at school however, sending paper letters home can be rather 'hit and miss' with letters often going astrav.

We are also increasingly aware of the substantial cost and environmental impact associated with the amount of paper and photocopying involved.

To help improve these areas we use a service called ParentMail which is used by over 2,500 schools across the UK to communicate with parents by email and text message.


