Dear Parents and Carers,

Many thanks to all the families for working with us last week during a time which saw very high rates of sickness and diarrhoea. The first recorded incident known to the school was the Friday before last with only three children recorded as being sick, not an unusually high number compared to other school weeks, but by the end of Monday last week this number had increased significantly. The school contacted Public Health England on Tuesday and distributed their letters. The peak was Wednesday of last week, with numbers steadily returning to normal. I would like to thank all the cleaning and site staff over the last week for their extra hard work shown in cleaning areas of high cross contamination such as toilets, handles, doors etc.

As a school we work hard to impress the importance of good hygiene with the pupils through the teaching of washing hands, use of tissues, which are readily available in every classroom. We would ask parents to support us with this. Please ensure your child has a water bottle in school every day. We work hard to maintain good attendance, however where a child has been sick and/or had diarrhoea they should be kept off school for 48 hours after the symptoms have stopped.

My thanks to the fourteen parents who attended the Curriculum Fayre last week. Those who attended said they had enjoyed and learned a lot about how the curriculum at St Nicholas. I was also encouraged about their suggestions at the meeting and will follow this up with those who attended. Congratulations to the Family of Four LEGOLAND ticket winner Caroline Lowrie.




