Registering for the Kent Test - Year 5 parents

If you want to apply for a Year 7 place at a Kent Grammar School, you can now register your child for the Kent Test. The test assesses whether grammar school is a suitable option for your child. You can register for the Kent Test online up to 3 July 2017. Follow the link to website for further information - http://www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/schools/school-places/kent-test

This year of the children who sat the Kent Test 55% of pupils passed either the Kent or Shepway test. Next year's test will take place on **Thursday 7**th **September 2017.**
