Nourish Online Payments

From 1st January 2018 Nourish are no longer able to offer the online payments as an option. Payment for school meals must be made on a Monday morning for the week ahead either by cash or a cheque made payable to Nourish Contract Catering. You can also pay monthly or termly.

Year 6 SATs meeting

There will be a meeting on **Thursday 18th January at 2.30pm** for Year 6 parents on the KS2 SATs.

The SATs tests are used to assess the the attainment of pupils against the programmes of study of the National Curriculum at the end of KS2 and will be used by secondary schools to predict future attainment.

During May 2018, the children undertake three National Curriculum tests; Reading, Grammar Punctuation & Spelling and Mathematics. Writing is assessed soley on the teachers judgement which is externally moderated.

To receive further details about the SATs (such as dates, exampled test papers, how to support your child at home to achieve the best possible outcomes and how to interprete standardised scores) we encourage you to attend a SATs information afternoon.

We do hope as many of you as possible are able to attend this important information event.

Parent Teacher Consultation – Advanced Notice.

Please be aware that the parent teacher consultations for the Spring term will take place on **Thursday 8th February 2018 3.30pm to 8.00pm** for ALL year groups. Do make a note in your diary so that you are able to attend this important event.

ParentMail Online Payments

From 1st January 2018 we will be using +Pay on ParentMail – an online payment service which allows you to pay for school items quickly and easily on your smartphone, tablet or computer. We will inform you about items you need to pay through ParentMail, and you will be able to pay electronically, using credit or debit cards. These will include school trips and clubs.

If you have an Android or Apple smartphone, we would highly recommend you download the free ParentMail App so that you can make easy, online payments on the go. To do this, simply search for "ParentMail" in your devices' App store. **Payments for school dinners are not able to be made through this system.**

If you do not wish to make payments online, you can of course, continue to make cash and cheque payments until February half term, after which point we hope all parents will see the benefit of online payments.
