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


Time Travellers Year One Homework Grid Spring Term Two 2018

<p><u>Maths</u> Can you write all the numbers to 50 counting in 1's, 2's 5's and 10's? e.g. 1,2,3,4,5 2,4,6,8, 5,10,15,20 10,20,30...</p>	<p><u>Collective Worship</u> Our theme for Collective worship this term is our value Respect / Justice. Can you draw a picture and write a sentence or two about how we can respect the people and objects in our school.</p>	<p><u>English</u> This term we will be learning the story of the Enormous Turnip. Can you write a story linked about your favourite vegetable?</p>
