- the following radio stations KMFM, BBC Radio Kent or Heart FM will announce school closures.
- A notice will be placed on the school's Twitter page @St_Nicholas_CEP

What can parents do to help?

- Please approach the school from the main school entrance.
- Don't forget suitable warm clothing coats, gloves, hats, scarves, wellies etc or even a change of clothing all clearly named
- If you are a working parent/carer or feel you may have a problem with a sudden earlier pick up, please put a back-up plan in place with another family member or parent and inform the school. This will allow staff to leave earlier for their safety if weather dictates.
- Please visit kent.gov.uk/winter for more information about gritting routes and travel issues around Kent so you can plan your journey.

If conditions worsen during the school day and parents/carers feel it is absolutely necessary to collect children the school should be contacted prior to collection.

ParentMail – Dinner Money Payments

From Friday 1st February you will be able to pay for your child's school lunches using ParentMail.

Under the Payments section of your ParentMail in the "Shop" tab there is an option for Nourish School Lunches.

If your child is in Year R, Year 1, Year 2 or Year 3-6 and entitled to Free School Meals then no payment needs to be made as they are entitled to the Universal Infant Free School Meal provided by the Government.

Please note that school lunches must be paid on a Monday for the week ahead.

Reminder - Important dates for Years 1, 2 and 6

Year 1 - The Year 1 phonics test will take place during the week beginning 10th June (Year 2 retakes will also take place during this week).

Year 2 - Year 2 SATs tests will take place during May.

Year 6 – Year 6 SATs tests will take place during the week beginning 13th May. These are National Tests and your child is required to attend school every day during this week.

Year 4 - The new Year 4 multiplication tables check is due to be taken during the three-week period from 10 June 2019 with the school involved in the pilot this year.

Please avoid making any appointments during these dates. No leave will be authorised for children in these year groups during this time.
