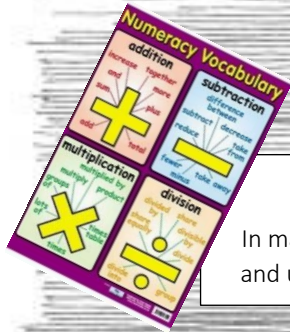
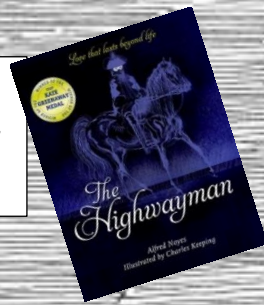


English and Focus Reading

Maths

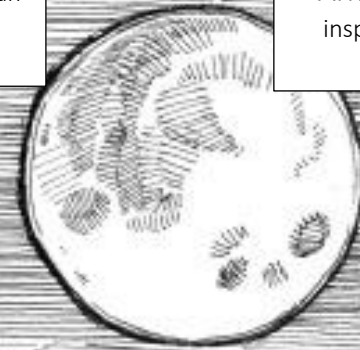
In maths, we will be focussing on place value and using the four operations for calculating.

We will be walking to the local churches and visiting some of the smuggling tunnels /geographical places of interest in New Romney.

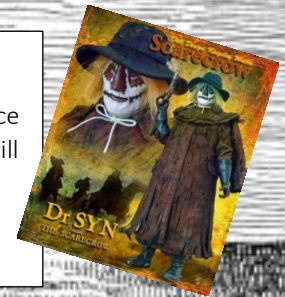
RE God - What does it mean if God is loving and holy?

PSHE

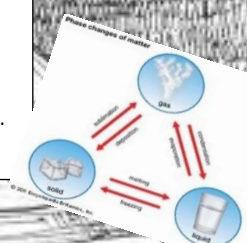
In PSHE, we will be learning about morals and values. We will be learning about the democratic system and in particular justice and freedom.
