Parents will be aware from the calandar sent out last week that we have already set the date for some trips and outings in the school year. Please note at the moment these are provisional dates and may change.


This year we will be letting parents know of the cost of the trips as soon as they have been booked. We hope that by doing this, it will allow families to plan and budget for these worthwhile activities.
