AGENDA:

With Lent fast approaching, the school council need to think about ways in which they can raise money.

1. Mrs Turner explained that we need to plan and organise events to raise money for our chosen charities during the period of Lent.
2. Mrs Turner explained that because it is Lent and we are a Christian Church school that these charities need to be Christian based and she gave some examples.
3. We recapped some of the fund-raising ideas from last year and had a discussion about some ideas for this year.

Ideas include:

- Easter egg raffle
- 10p coin race but teachers also race against the children – maybe in separate key stages
- Easter Egg hunt
- Easter Fair – each class plans a stall and it is on the last Friday afternoon of term
- Tag Day – come to school dressed Easter themed (animals, eggs, spring colours etc)
- Easter bonnet competition on the same day
- Design an Easter card competition / colouring competition
