Subject	Work at home ideas
Reading	<p>Refer to the link Miss Reynolds put on Dojo for further phonics lessons</p> <p>https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/26331.html - set 2 slideshow</p> <p>https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/26334.html - set 3 slideshow</p> <p>These can be practiced daily – go through all of the sounds. Pick one or two sounds to focus on. Write words including those sounds. Write sentences using those words.</p> <p>Reading- Once you have listened to ‘The Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch’, (see link below in English) complete the reading comprehension.</p> <p>Online then offline activity</p>

There are 5 lessons – you can choose a couple to do or complete all 5.</p> <p>1-Create your own ‘Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch’ storyboard.</p>

There is a template to use and an example sheet to show you what to do.

2- Setting description – Where do they live? What does the house look like? Use adjectives to describe what you can see. ***The cool crystal blue sea crashed against the rocks.***

3 – create your own favourite meal. You can draw it or actually make it and take a photograph.

4 – Speech bubbles of the characters feelings
