Please continue to read the story with mum, dad or one of your sisters or brothers. Perhaps you could do this as a family together.

You need to be able to say the story out loud just like the Little Red Hen and Mr Wiggle and Mr Waggle. Try and make some actions for your story



This week we are going to read and learn some of the more difficult words from the story. Can you spot any adjectives from the words you will be reading with your parents? These are the Ladybird words. You can read these with your parents. Try and 'Fred Talk' some of them with them and ask for help

when you find it too tricky.

The next activity asks you to pretend to be characters from the story. You are very good at pretending so this should be easy to do. You could also ask your family to join in.

The last activity is all about rhyme. It is a cute poem about a flea. Maybe you could find some more poems about bugs, magic or cats and tell us about them on a video clip or ask your parents to help you write it out and post it onto our class page. Ask your parents to have a look for 'Forgiven' by AA Milne this is a lovely poem about a bug.
