Dear Parents and Carers,

Once again, another week of home learning has flown by and we have seen a vast array of super activities being completed by the children. I would like to express my thanks and gratitude to you all for your continued support during these uncertain times.

All **Zoom** meetings are now posted on your child's class page n DoJo, with the link and password available to parents. Please don't share this information with anyone and make sure your family name is available for teachers to welcome you to the meeting.

With regards to the Prime Minister's announcement last night. As I said in my message to parents via 'DoJo,' we now wait for further details from the government as to when & how the return to school will take place.

The return will require considerable planning, unless we're told a normal classroom set up is proven to be safe, we will have to split a class over two classrooms. If we have R, 1 & 6 in school and halve them, that's 12 groups of children in our school as we have 2 classes per year group! This means I will have to use all available classroom space. When I also consider the support required for Key Workers and vulnerable families as well that means I will have no additional space within the school. While many of Year 6 will be able to walk to school, all the YR & Y1 will have an adult dropping off and collecting. I need to consider how we can utilise space & staff to spread the children as safely as possible.

I will be working to develop a strategy to liaise with parents and at some point find out those of you who are parents of children in Year 6, 1 & R who will be returning to work, to see how many children we are likely to be taking. I am sure there will be many who will make the choice not to send their child to school.

I will of course keep you up to date with how things progress but as you can see, there are more questions than I have answers at present.
