Ensuring your child is secure in all these sounds is vital to developing their reading skills so please continue to practice these daily or use the sounds provided in their original packs.

Set 1	Set 1 Speed Sounds Set 1 Word Time - reading Set 1 Spelling
Set 2	Set 2 Speed Sounds Set 2 Spelling (With new words for reading and spelling)
Set 3	Set 3 Speed Sounds Set 3 Spelling (With new words for reading and spelling)
Read and Hold a Sentence 1 (Available 15 th June)	For children reading and writing with Set 1 sounds confidently and learning Set 2 sounds. (Green, Purple, Pink and Orange Read Write Inc. Storybooks)
Read and Hold a Sentence 2 (Available 15 th June)	For children reading and writing words with Set 2 sounds confidently and learning Set 3 sounds. (Yellow, Blue and Grey Read Write Inc. Storybooks)
Red Words 1	For children reading Red, Green, Purple, Pink and Orange Read Write Inc. Storybooks. (Many children are able to read these in Reception.)
Red Words 2	For children reading Yellow, Blue and Grey Storybooks. (Many children are able to read these in Y1.)
Longer words	For children who can read Set 3 sounds and words confidently.
