RE Term 3 New Testament Stories


(It is up to you when you do RE but we won't be setting Literacy and Maths lessons on a Friday)

This week's question is How was Jesus special?


Jesus needed help to share the message of God.

Luke 5: 1-11

Simon answered, "Master we worked hard all night trying to catch fish, but we caught nothing. But you say to put the nets in the water ; so I will." The fishermen did as Jesus told them. The friends came, and both boats were filled so full that they were almost sinking.
