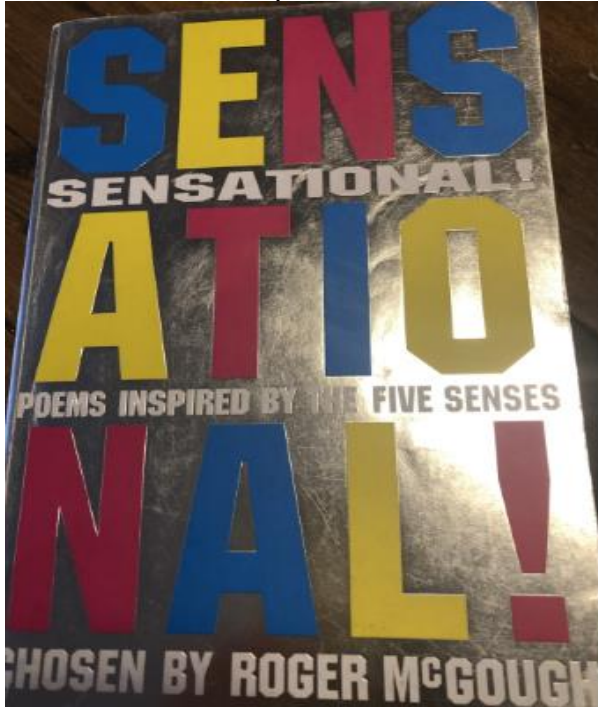


Thursday 25th February
