These week we are looking at another way of making a /shuhl/ sound:

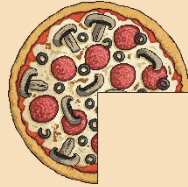


'-tial' as in mar**tial**

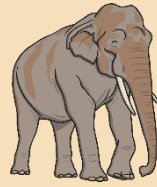

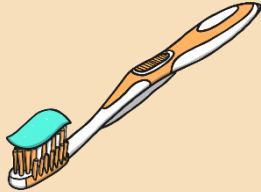

means that the sound is spelt using '**-tial**'.
