

PSHE Safety and the Changing Body

Children will learn:

- What the internet is, how to communicate online safely and what to do if something makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe.
- The concept of privacy and the correct vocabulary for body parts.
- About appropriate contact, safe and unsafe touches.
- Road safety.
- How to stay safe with medicine.

Science

- Identify and name a variety of common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees, and those classified as deciduous and evergreen
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common plants including roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.
- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Art, DT and Music

Children will learn:

- Proportion when sketching self portraits
- To use natural materials to create images.
- To identify a range of musical instruments and how they create sounds.
- To design and create a musical instrument.
- To design and create a garden mobile.

Maths

.Time - o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to.
Position and direction - describing movement and turns, clockwise, anti-clockwise, left, right.
4 operations: adding numbers to 100, subtracting numbers to 100, dividing by 2,5 and 10, multiplying by 2,5 and 10.
