

#### Attendance – Every Day Counts

It is extremely important that children are on time for school so that they have a settled and productive start to their morning. When children are frequently late for school this adds up to lost learning time. The graph below shows the attendance level for each class across the school – the national minimum standard for schools is a 95% attendance rate. Currently most classes do <u>NOT</u> meet the governments national minimum standard. This impacts negatively on your child.
