Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sure you have seen the building work for the new classrooms is already well underway. This term has already seen a number of changes across the school, including the complete refurbishment of both our mobile classes with new windows, doors and a roof refurbishment. Over the summer holiday we will see the largest schedule of works of any school I have ever worked in.

Works will include;

- Development of the new Specialist Resource Provision, refurbishing two classrooms and a new outside area.
- Replacement of the school boilers with a new air source heat pump system along with solar panel installation.
- The redecoration and refurbishment of the Year R & 1 classrooms.
- The redecoration and refurbishment of the Year 3 and 4 toilets.
- The installation of a site wide wifi6 with 10Gbps installation to improve our internet connectivity to support pupils learning.

All these works highlight a considerable investment in the future of St Nicholas, with over £1.5 million being spent to develop the school for current and future generations. All this work, ties in with my desire to ensure we are a successful 2-form entry school which our community can be proud of, while at the same time provide the best learning environment we can for all our pupils.

Attendance - Every Day Counts

It is extremely important that children are on time for school so that they have a settled and productive start to their morning. When children are frequently late for school this adds up to lost learning time.

The national minimum standard for schools is 95% attendance. Currently most classes <u>DO</u>

<u>NOT</u> meet the governments national minimum standard and this impacts negatively on children.

At St Nicholas, Learning begins immediately with SODA – Start of Day Activities when the class doors open at 8.30am, when many additional interventions are also scheduled for this time, which may include your child.

Please be in school on time - lateness affects everyone's learning
