History – The Tudors

- To find out about life in Tudor Britain
- To retell the story of the Battle of Bosworth
- To examine Tudor portraits and explain how a piece of Art makes people think and feel
- To investigate King Henry VIII
- To name and speak about his wives
- To investigate life in Tudor society
- To investigate crime and punishment in Tudor times



Science – Light

- Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines.
- Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.
- Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.
- Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

RE: Gospels- What would Jesus do?

- the features of Gospel texts (for example, teachings, parable, narrative)
- the context, how to suggest meanings of Gospel texts and compare their ideas with ways in which Christians interpret biblical texts, showing an awareness of different interpretations.
- making clear connections between Gospel texts, Jesus' 'good news', and how Christians live in the Christian community and in their individual lives.
- how to relate biblical ideas, teachings or beliefs (for example, about peace, forgiveness, healing) to the issues, problems and opportunities of their own lives and the life of their own community in the world today, offering insights of their own.
