Dear Parents and Carers

It's been another very busy week here at St Nicholas. We have had two events showing parents around the school before applications for starting school in September close this weekend. If you have a child due to start school in September and you have siblings at the school you must complete and submit the application by midnight tonight.

We have had a number of sporting activities for children take place this week and I am sure Class Dojo pages have been very busy with the different activities taking place.

Attendance

I am sure there are times when parents think all I am concerned about is attendance. That said it is very important for your child to be in school every day and on time, as this has a significant impact on learning if children are not in or late. It is also a key feature of any school inspection and OfSTED will review the school's processes to see how robust they are. The obvious measure for this is the attendance percentage. A present our whole school is attendance rate is 92.4% and the government expectation is for 96%.

Holiday Requests

Parents will often request that I authorise their request for holiday. The government removed the Headteacher's ability to authorise leave of absence for a family holiday in September 2014 and as such made the rule that all leave requests in term time would be unauthorised apart from 'exceptional circumstances' and this can only be agreed in advance of the leave. Unfortunately, despite many requests for me to look at their holiday request as a special exception, I am not able to do so. If a holiday is then taken a penalty notice request is made and a fine is issued by the local authority. The school has no recourse to overturn this action.

School Car Park

Please may I take this opportunity to remind all parents that our car park is not for public use at the start and end of day collections. We have had a number of incidents this week where children have been meeting parents in the car park. Our risk assessment is clear - parents' cars and pupils should NOT be in the car park for any length of time. This is to ensure the safety of your children!


