Computing

PE

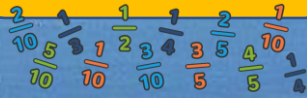
Athletics

Rounders - learning the basic rules of the game, practising batting and catching skills.



Maths

Fractions of amounts; adding and subtracting fractions; shape; finding duration of time and finding measure.



PSHE

This term, the children will be learning about what to do in an emergency, how to keep safe by the road and how to deal with influences from others.

DT

The children will be learning how technology can help us solve problems, how we can design a product and market it.



French

With the circle of life as a theme, the children will be discovering more about the gender of French nouns and agreement with adjectives.

Science – 'Light'

The children will be learning about light, what is darkness, how are shadows formed and investigating transparent, translucent and opaque materials.



Geography

'South America - Rio and Brazil'

The children will be looking at the South American continent, focusing on Rio and the Amazon rainforest.



Music

With the theme of rainforests, the children will be exploring body and tuned percussion.
