

Year 6 Parents – Secondary School Applications Information

Applications for transfer to secondary school for September 2024 close at midnight on **Tuesday 31 October 2023.** If you have not already done so your child's application must be completed by this date.

For those whose children sat the 11+ - The 11+ assessment decision will be sent to you by Wednesday 18 October 2023. Results will be sent by email after 4pm to parents who applied providing an email address, and letters will be posted first class to all other parents.

Online applicants can view their child's assessment and test scores after 5pm on results day by logging back into their online application.

Normally at this time of the year many of the secondary schools will have Open Days/Evenings for parents to visit with their children. As we are made aware of these we will pass this information on.
