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Dear Parents and Carers,

Next week schools across the United Kingdom take part in Anti-Bullying week. At St Nicholas we will have a number of events in pupils PSHE teaching and assemblies where we will explore the themes of this year's anti-bullying week. This year's theme is 'Make A Noise About Bullying.'

As part of this year's Anti-Bullying Week campaign, we are urging everyone to think about what we mean by 'banter', the role 'banter' plays in bullying and how we can tackle it. Banter and jokes can play an important role in the development and maintenance of friendships. Banter is defined as 'the playful and friendly exchange of teasing remarks.' However, sometimes these behaviours can be taken too far such that the behaviours constitute bullying.


