MFL Long Term Plan 2023-24

We teach French as our modern foreign language throughout KS2 and we take part in the annual European Day of Languages and Bastille Day celebrations. French is planned to ensure that the key objectives for: speaking and listening, reading and writing and intercultural understanding are fully covered. To enable accurate assessment, all aspects of the MFL curriculum need to be taught and evidenced. Children in years 5 and 6 have French pen pals from our twinned school and will either visit them in France or they will come over to us. The children in Year 6 also take part in projects with the French school. Although the teaching of MFL is primarily taught in KS2, younger children may be exposed to alternative languages in more informal ways, for example European Day of Languages and Bastille Day. Within each topic, all the key objectives are covered. French is taught for 30mins a week.
