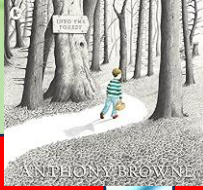


Year 3 – Term 4

Maths

We will learn about length and know how to find the perimeter of shapes. We will learn about unit and non – unit fractions. We will know how to order these on a number line. We will also learn about mass and capacity.



English

We will be reading traditional fairy tales and exploring how we can put different 'twists' into them. We will start by reading 'Into the Forest'.

We will know how to write a biography about Hans Christian Anderson. We will be creating a persuasive brochure about our local area.



Science - Forces

We will know about friction and how it can be applied. We will explore magnetic and non – magnetic objects. We will find out how magnetic poles attract or repel.

Painting – Pattern and colour.

We will study the artist Norval Morrisseau. We will learn about the colour wheel and experiment with patterns.

Computing - Journey inside a computer.

We will know about input and output. We will learn about a computer's memory and how it processes instructions.

Online safety.

Geography - Are all settlements the same?

We will know about settlements and how land is used in our local area. We will explore how it has changed over time. We will compare this to New Delhi.

Music - Traditional instruments and improvisation.

We will listen to Indian music and use given notes to improvise a piece.

We will continue to learn about resilience and feelings. We will also explore diet and dental health.
