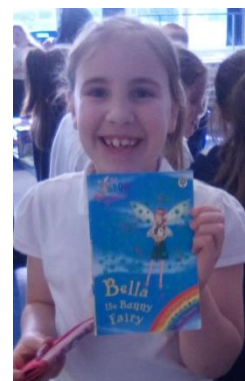
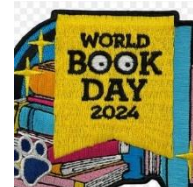


Spring Term Reading Newsletter

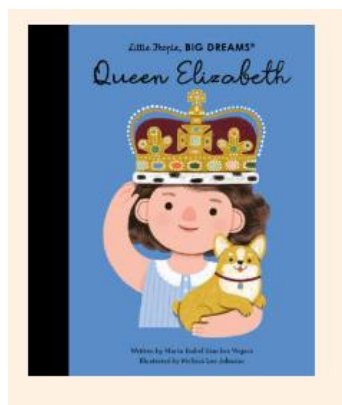


Welcome, dreamers!
