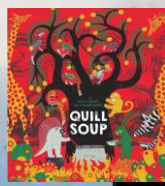


Year 3 – Term 5



English

We will be writing an adventure story. We will learn how to write a letter of persuasion and how to create a set of instructions. We will also learn how to write a perform a persuasive speech. We will learn about imperative verbs, chronological order, tenses and dialogue.



Maths

We will continue to learn about mass and capacity. We will learn more about fractions, including adding, subtracting and fractions of amounts. We will learn about using money and how to tell the time and calculate time.

Geography

We will be learning about Antarctica, including climate, lines of latitude and longitude. We will explore its physical and human features. We will learn about Shackleton and his expedition.



Music

We will learn about ballads and the stories they tell. We will create our own ballad.

PSHE

We will learn about money, budgeting and the impact of spending. We will also learn careers for the future.

DT

The children will be learning how technology can help us solve problems, how we can design a product and market it.

Science

We will learn about the parts of plants and their functions. We will explore how plants grow. We will find out about stem and water transportation. We will look at seed dispersal, pollination and life cycles.

PE

French

We will learn key vocabulary and phrases linked to transport. We will identify words that are cognates.

RE

Our topic is Kingdom of God. We will explore the big question:
When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?
