




English

The Great Kapok Tree

Science - Habitats and Deforestation

The children will be looking at living things and their habitats, classifying animals and plants and looking at the human impact on environment, including deforestation.

Geography

Why are rainforests important to us?

We will be looking at where rainforests can be found in the world and why they are so important. We will focus on the Amazon rainforest and the people that live there. We will also be looking at how rainforests are changing.



RE

What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?

The children will be learning how Hindus show their faith within their families, exploring the four aims of life and Hindu ideas of karma.



PSHE - Safety and Changing Body

This term the children will be looking at how asthma affects people, the risks associated with smoking and the difference between privacy and secrecy. They will also look at the physical changes to our bodies as we grow from children to adults.

Computational Thinking

We will be learning how to break down problems into clear, efficient instructions, learning about decomposition, abstraction, pattern recognition and algorithms.



DT - Adapting Recipes

The children will be learning a basic biscuit recipe and adapting it.



French - Food

The children will be learning how to order food and drink in a French café, using French money, shopping in France for food and they will be creating a French menu.

PE

Physical – developing and applying our reactions and responses and balance.

Maths
