

The Great Kapok Tree

This term, we will be extending our theme of rainforests to our English lessons, creating our own writing based on the Great Kapok Tree by Lynne Cherry.



Computational Thinking

We will be learning how to break down problems into clear, efficient instructions, learning about decomposition, abstraction, pattern recognition and algorithms.

Maths

In our maths lessons, we will be looking at decimal numbers in tenths and hundredths and comparing them to fractions.

Our mastering number lessons will continue to focus on learning times tables in readiness for the MTC.

We will explore the contrasting qualities of legato and staccato in classical music, learning to perform music using different articulation and conveying emotions through their playing.
