

# From the Headteachers desk... Investing in our pupils' futures....

Last Friday, I had the opportunity to attend a national PiXL leadership conference, bringing together leaders from over 7,000 schools across the country. PiXL (Partners in Excellence) is a well-established network focused on improving outcomes for all children, and it was inspiring to connect with so many professionals who share a passion for making education the best it can be.

A key focus of the conference was how schools can become more accessible and connected to parents. We know that strong partnerships between home and school have a significant impact on children's progress and wellbeing, and I'm excited to bring back ideas and strategies to strengthen this further in our own school community. Over the coming months, and as we move into the next academic year, I look forward to sharing more about how we plan to develop this work with you.

Alongside this, our school leadership team has been working closely with colleagues from **White Rose Maths** this week. We are very pleased to announce that we will be entering into a new partnership with White Rose research team from September. This is a high-quality, research-informed approach to teaching mathematics, and we believe it will have a positive and lasting impact on our pupils' learning.

To support this work, we are committing a significant investment of over **£8,000** into our maths curriculum next year. At a time when schools are facing increasing financial pressures, I want to assure you that we remain fully committed to investing in the very best opportunities and resources for our children.

This week, we were pleased to be led in a thoughtful and reflective Eucharist service by **Rev. Chris**, which was a meaningful experience for both staff and pupils. We are grateful for his continued support and spiritual guidance within our school community.

Following the service, **Year 4 and Year 5 pupils** will have the opportunity over the coming week to meet with Rev. Chris to discuss **confirmation**. These informal conversations will allow pupils to explore what confirmation means and whether they would like to be considered for taking this next step in their faith journey.

If your child expresses an interest in confirmation, further information will be shared with you in due course. We are proud to support pupils in their spiritual development and look forward to seeing how their faith continues to grow through these opportunities.


