Charlie and the Chocolate Factory


This term we will be enjoying this classic story and working on our descriptive writing to deliver delicious sentences!



Science

The Digestive System

The children will be looking at how our digestive system works, going on a journey with our food as it travels from our mouths and through our bodies.



RE

Green Religion -How should we care for the world, and why does it matter?

The children will be learning about different faiths' views on the environment, from worldviews, to Christianity, Islam and Hindu Dharma.



History

Why is 1066 important to us?

The children will understand who were the contenders for the throne in 1066. They will know about the Battle of Stamford Bridge and the Battle of Hastings. We will find out about Norman castles and learn about life in Norman times under the feudal system.



PSHE

Economic wellbeing

This term the children will learn about the value of money – looking at the importance of tracking expenditure, determining value for money, looking at what factors influence our buying decisions and understanding bank accounts.

Computing

Data Handling

We will be learning about data and how to use information we collect to help us. Using a theme of weather, the children will understand the vast amounts of data collected to enable accurate forecasts to be made.
