In **reading**, 77% of pupils met the expected standard, *up* from 75% in 2024.

In **maths**, 71.4% of pupils met the expected standard, *up* 8.9% from 62.5% in 2024

In **writing**, 77% of pupils met the expected standard, the *same* as 2024

In **grammar, punctuation and spelling**, 70% of pupils met the expected standard, *up* 15% from 55% since 2024

Attainment in all of reading, writing and maths (combined) increased compared to 2024

In all of **reading, writing and maths**, 55.4% of pupils met the expected standard, *up* 5.4% from 50% in 2024.

The average scaled scores in reading, maths, and grammar, punctuation and spelling tests nationally have remained the same as 2023.

In reading, the average scaled score is 105, nationally the scaled score is 106.

In maths, the average scaled score is 103.5, nationally the scaled score is 105

In grammar, punctuation and spelling, the average scaled score is 103, nationally the scaled score is 105.
