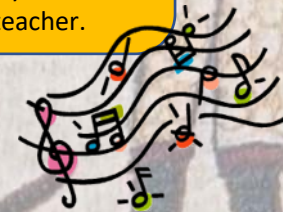
My healthy self: How can I make healthy choices?

The children will learn how healthy choices support both physical and mental wellbeing by exploring exercise, nutrition and hydration.

History

Why is 1066 important to us?

The children will understand who were the contenders for the throne in 1066. They will know about the Battle of Stamford Bridge and the Battle of Hastings. We will find out about Norman castles and learn about life in Norman times under the feudal system.

Creation - Our big question this term is 'What do Christians learn from the creation story?'



Science

What is the same and different about living things?

The children will be identifying, sorting and grouping animals (inc. vertebrates and invertebrates) using classification keys.

Maths

Place Value - We will be learning about the place value of digits in numbers up to 10,000, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 or 1,000 and learning Roman numerals.

Addition and Subtraction - We will be adding and subtracting multiples of 1000 and numbers up to 4 digits.
