Computing: What is a computer?

In this unit, the children will explore how computers work, how to log in safely and how to save digital work.

Maths

Place Value

We will be learning about the place value of digits in numbers up to 100.

Addition and Subtraction

We will begin this unit by revising number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.

PSHE - Families and Relationships

This term's unit focuses on understanding how everyday choices support health and wellbeing by exploring the effects of movement, sleep, food and drink on the body.

Science - Animals' needs for survival

The children will be identifying different mammals, birds, fish, amphibians and reptiles and exploring their needs for survival. They will then learn about how humans can stay healthy.

Who made the world?

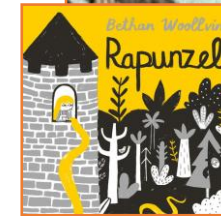


DT - Structures
